Day 6

Morning Safari - Sigagule Children's Center to visit with staff and children from a local village. - Evening Safari

Day 7

Morning Safari - Participate in a Rotary Service Project if host club schedule permits. - Evening Safari

Day 8

Morning Safari – Breakfast – Depart reserve destination Jo'burg.

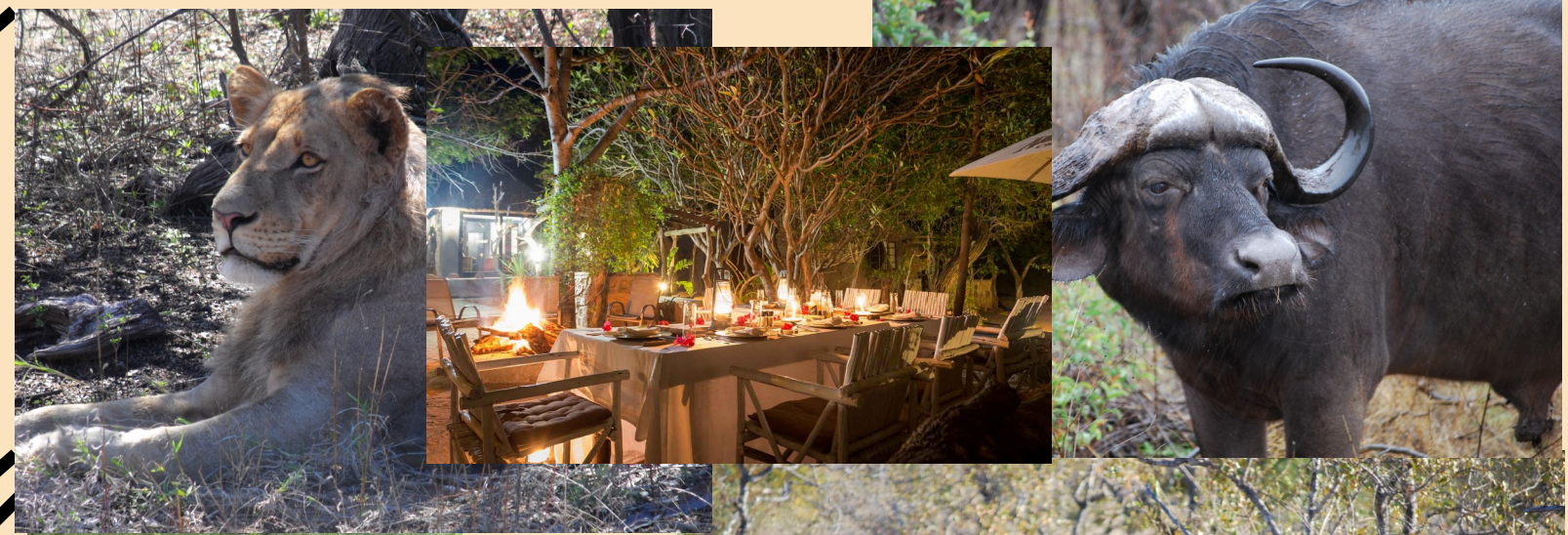


Bushveld Experience

**Dr. Tom L. Tochtermann: Since 2009 Dicerons Founder Tom Tochtermann has traveled frequently to the Republic of South Africa spending most of his time in the bushveld of the Greater Kruger National Park. His passion for the savannah landscape began, like many other visitors, after his first photo safari. At one point in his safari he had the 'ah ha' moment and was so amazed at how the experience affected him he began to ask himself why. The moment was so powerful it led him to go back to school and study the mental phenomenon of his 'ah ha'. He began a journey leading to a PhD; researching the influence of cognitive dissonance on the consumption of natural resources and ecosystem degradation. Dr. Tom was awarded his doctorate in 2016.

Dr. Tom is founder and President of Rhino Mercy, a US non-profit 501c3 tax exempt organization whose mission is to 1) aid in the fight against wildlife crime and specifically the poaching of rhino in South Africa, 2) support youth environmental education programs and scientific research, 3) support the development of technology for use in conservation, and 4) encourage volunteerism in support of conservation initiatives. Tom co-authored the Balule Rhino Conservation Plan and the internationally recognized all female anti-poaching unit named The Black Mamba APU; the unit was awarded the United Nations Champion of the Earth award in 2016 and has been the subject of numerous documentaries and journal articles.
